### OBJECTIVE OF THE ROLE

Conduct work as a member of the Engineering team and deliver the planned performance of the department safely, with zero injuries and at the lowest practical unit cost.  
 Comply with company requirements to safely, correctly and efficiently complete approved work and tasks.  
 Carry out fuel delivery to equipment in the pit areas and other areas as required.  
 Drive the fuel truck and dispense fuel to equipment.

### ROLE ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Ensure safe working procedures are followed for all refuelling operations.
- Strictly adhere to GGM Safety policies and practises.
- Be trustworthy and diligent when carrying out your duties.
- Show initiation and respect to interact with the team.
- Be punctual and on time when reporting for duty.
- Conduct pre-shift inspections and record any defects; if any no-go item is identified, report immediately to your supervisor and arrange for the truck to go to the LME workshop for repair.
- Keep the interior of the cab and the outside of the fuel bowser clean and in good order.
- Check the volume of fuel loaded in the truck, ensure the correct volume, and recheck the previous shift refuelling record before proceeding.
- Ensure the outgoing shift leaves the fuel bowsers parked while the bulk tank is loaded full at the required maximum volume.
- Sign and accept the amount of fuel received into the fuel bowser together with the Puma fuel attendant.
- Inspect the metering unit, including the LC Meter and the LAS controller, to ensure numbers are visible for correct recording of volumes dispensed.
- Demonstrate basic numerical competence when recording meter readings.
- Record the meter reading before starting the new shift to enable reconciliation of fuel received with fuel dispensed at the end of the shift.
- Drive to the road and weather conditions at all times and protect the fuel truck from unnecessary damage when travelling to different refuelling locations.
- Refuel equipment as per the schedule provided by your supervisor.
- Follow the schedule and adhere to any changes or instructions given by your supervisor.
- React immediately to requests regarding equipment that has run out of fuel by maintaining radio contact with the Mining pit operation Supervisor.
- Always fill equipment tanks to full; the pump will shut off automatically when full. Lighting plants are the exception, where a predetermined amount is stipulated, currently 30 litres.
- Eliminate fuel loss by accurately recording the correct meter reading in the fuel dispensing sheet with all information captured, including equipment number, engine hour meter readings, date, time, volume, and the ID number and signature of the equipment operator after refuelling each equipment in your shift.
- Report any sign or indication of fuel theft immediately and do not attempt to or collude with others to steal fuel.
- Check that the LAS fuel management system controller on the fuel truck is operative and synchronised with the manual Liquid Control meter; if not, report to the LAS Technician immediately. Report any equipment that has a defective breather, fuel leak or faulty LAS fuel tag after refuelling.

- Conduct a fuel reconciliation between fuel received and fuel dispensed at the end of your shift; figures must tally and the remaining fuel balance must be confirmed and accounted for.
- Ensure zero loss during your shift and report to the Security Fuel Reconciliation Officer after your shift to submit your fill sheet.
- Provide an explanation for any unaccounted fuel loss.
- If unable to account for any loss, understand that an investigation will take place and necessary disciplinary action may be taken, including termination if found guilty.
- Be aware of socializing with unscrupulous individuals who have hidden agendas.
